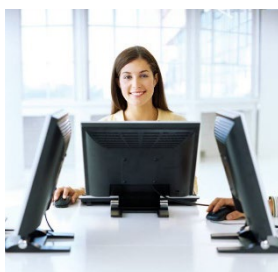


Assessment Learning Institute Schedule
